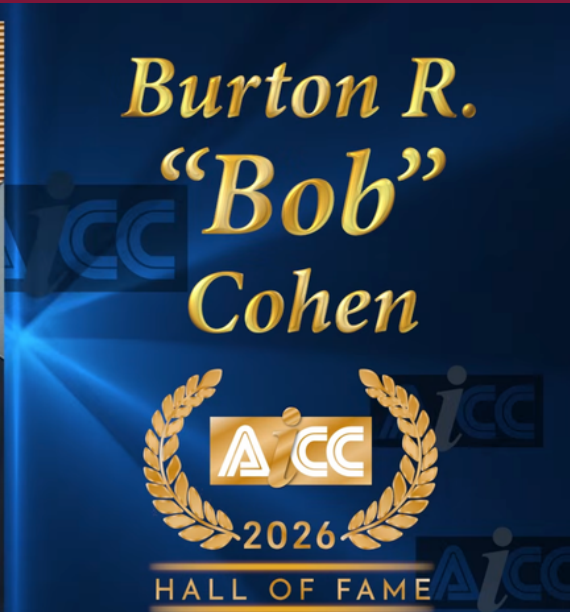

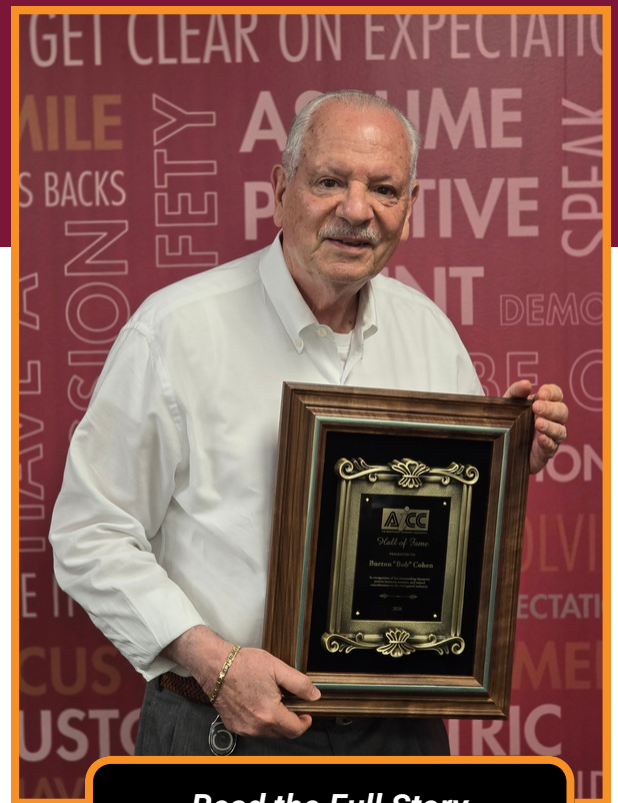

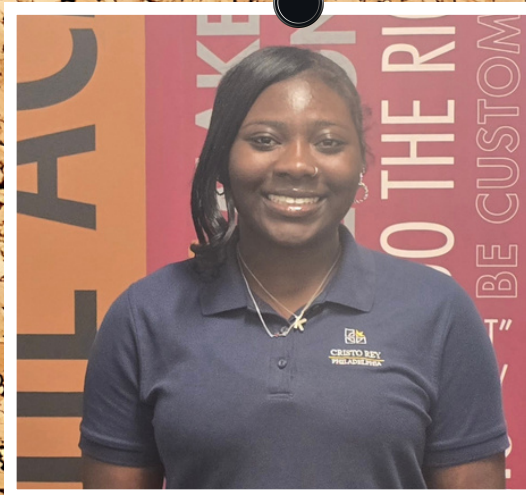
"No entrepreneur succeeds in isolation. To be truly successful you must cultivate a culture that supports success."

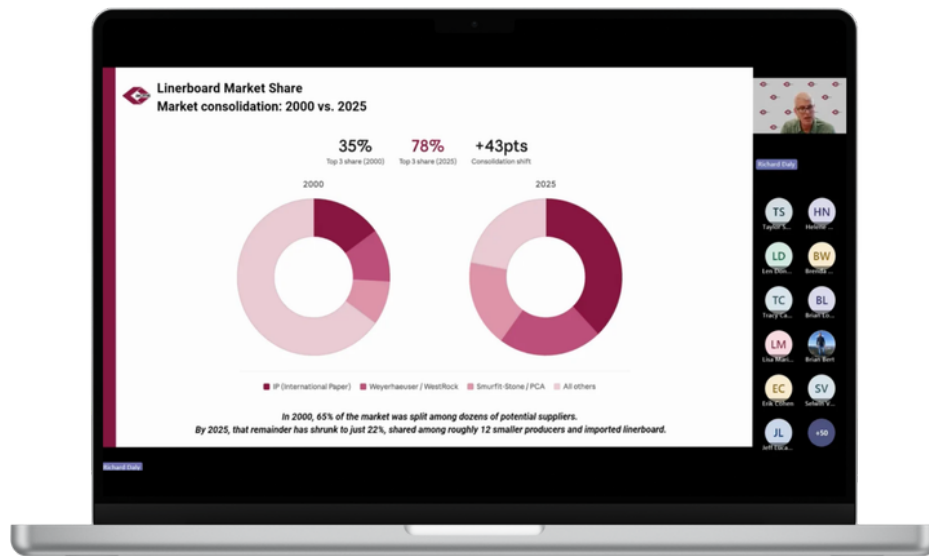
